

Cumberland Valley AMATEUR RADIO CLUB (CVARC) NET SCRIPT

27 April 2025

Good evening, everyone and welcome.

This is **[callsign and phonetic callsign]** my name is _____ and I am now calling the **Cumberland Valley Amateur Radio Club Net** into session. I am Net Control and located in

This net meets every Sunday night at 7:30 PM local time.

We operate on the Chambersburg repeater using a frequency of **147.120 MHz** with a positive offset and a PL tone of **100.0 Hz**.

[BREAK]

The purpose of **this** Net is to handle traffic into and out of the coverage area, exchange information, test the repeater operations, improve the operations of our ham radio equipment and enjoy each other's company.

If you have an emergency anytime during this Net, please state the word "Emergency" with your call sign phonetically and repeat, as necessary. The frequency will be turned over to you, and we will assist as needed. Emergency traffic pertains to the preservation of life or property.

Any station having emergency traffic, please call Net Control NOW.

(Wait 10 seconds, handle emergency traffic and then move ahead with call for announcements).

Any Stations with announcements for the net, please call Net Control NOW.

(Acknowledge stations with announcements and allow each station to make any announcements in turn)

All licensed amateurs are invited and encouraged to participate in this Net. You do not have to be a club member to participate. You may also check us out on the web at **www.W3ACH.com** to find repeater information and how you can become a supporter or member of the club.

[TRAFFIC HANDLING PROCEDURE]

This is a **directed net**. All non-emergency traffic will be handled once we have gone through regular check-in but before we have general discussion.

[REGULAR ROLLCALL]

This is **[callsign]**, Net Control. We will now begin our call for check-ins.

(do not use member list for check-ins. Allow stations to call in any order)

When checking in, please call Net Control, let the repeater drop to avoid doubling with another station, then, give your **call sign phonetically, your name, location, and if you have traffic. Please speak CLEARLY and SLOWLY so that I can copy.**

Stations checking into the net please call now:

(Take check-ins and acknowledge each station once check ins are complete).

This is **[callsign]**, Net Control now calling for any **late stations**.

(Take and acknowledge and additional check-ins at this point).

[HANDLE TRAFFIC]

(if no traffic ... go into General Discussion)

*(if traffic) This is **[callsign]** ... we will now handle all traffic before we get into general discussion.*

[GENERAL DISCUSSION]

This is **[callsign]**. We'll now start at the top of the roster and ask for comments.

We will start with _____.

(call sign and name)

(Start at the top of the roster and work to the bottom of the list.)

[Final Call for late check-ins]

This is **[callsign]**, Net Control. Are there any additional check-ins for the CVARC Net tonight. Please call now.

(Take any additional check-ins, acknowledge each station, and ask if they have any comments. If no additional check-ins, move on to conclusion)

[CONCLUSION]

This is **[callsign]** Net Control thanking everyone for participating and making ***this, your net*** possible. We give thanks to the folks providing and maintaining this repeater.

We invite you to come back every Sunday night at 7:30 PM local time, when the Cumberland Valley Amateur Radio Club Net will be called back into session.
